#### **Sacrament of Baptism**

Parish Registration and the Baptism class are required. Baptisms are held every Sunday of each month at 1:30 p.m. in the Church Baptistery. Please contact the parish secretary to register for the Baptism classes.



Plan to attend the classes before the birth of the child.

#### What does it mean to be an active Catholic?

Frequently, those seeking to celebrate Marriage, have children baptized, or serve as sponsors for Confirmation or Baptism request a letter stating that they are parishioners and active, practicing Catholics. To receive such a letter, one must be registered in the parish for at least 3 months, attend Mass regularly, and be committed to a stewardship of time, talent, and treasure. We encourage all parishioners to become active in one of the parish organizations. In a community as large as Our Lady of Hope, one means of verifying participation is through the use of parish offertory envelopes. If you choose not to participate in the support of the parish, or are unable to contribute at this time, please at least note your prayerful support on your envelope and place it in the weekly offertory. We will then be aware of your continued participation, and you will not be noted as "inactive" on our parish roster.



## Ask Your Pastor

"Are we required to tithe 10% of our income, by penalty of mortal sin?"

As cited in the Catechism (#2043), the Precepts of the

Church maintain that each person has the duty to support the material needs of the Church. Of course a person fulfills this obligation according to his abilities. The Code of Canon Law also states, "The Christian faithful are obliged to assist with the needs of the Church so that the Church has what is necessary for divine worship, for apostolic works and works of charity, and for the decent sustenance of ministers" (#222). However, the Church does not mandate a tithe as such of any percentage of income or other resource.

In the Old Testament, we do find the "10%" rule: A person offered to God or "tithed" one-tenth of the harvest of grain of the fields or the produce of the fruit of the trees, one-tenth of new pressed wine and oil, and every tenth firstborn animal of herd or flock. (See Leviticus 23:30-33, Deuteronomy 12:17, 14:22-29.)

Although we may not have a rule of tithing, we do have the duty to support the needs of the Church. Each person should evaluate what he does "give back to God" through his support of the church and charitable organizations. A person should ask, "Do I give to God each week at least what I spend on entertainment, such as movies? Do I give to God at least one hour's worth of my forty-hour pay check?" St. Paul praised the generosity of the Macedonians (II Corinthians 8:1-7): "In the midst of severe trial their overflowing joy and deep poverty have produced an abundant generosity. According to their means—indeed I can testify even beyond their means—and voluntarily, they begged us insistently for the favor of sharing in this service to members of the Church." Each of us should be more of a "tither" than a "tipper" in returning a portion of our bounty back to God.

#### **Congratulations!**


