

## PARISH INFORMATION

**What does it mean to be an active Catholic?** Those seeking to celebrate Marriage, have children baptized, or have a letter signed to serve as sponsors for Confirmation or Baptism should be parishioners and active, practicing Catholics. ***To be considered active, one must have been registered in the parish for at least three months, attend Mass regularly, and be committed to a stewardship of time, talent, and treasure.*** We encourage all parishioners to become active in one of the parish organizations.

In a community as large as Our Lady of Hope, our most effective means of verifying active participation is through the use of parish offertory envelopes or electronic giving, such as Faith Direct. If you choose not to participate in the support of the parish, or are unable to contribute at this time, please note your prayerful support on your envelope and place it in the weekly offertory. We will then be aware of your continued participation, and you will not be noted as "inactive" on our parish roster.

## PREPARING FOR SACRAMENTS

**Baptism & Baptism Class:** Baptisms are held on Sundays at 1:30 p.m. The baptism class for parents is held one Saturday a month at 11:00 a.m. Please call the Parish Secretary to pre-register for the next available class.

**Sacrament of Matrimony:** In accordance with the regulations of the Bishop of Arlington, couples must contact a priest and begin preparation at least six months prior to the wedding.

Parish registration and active participation for a minimum of three months is required *before* preparation may begin.

Couples who are living together will be asked to live separately during the preparation time as living together before marriage is sinful and harmful to the future marriage.

**First Communion:** For Children: Generally, First Communion is received when a child is in second grade. Preparation for First Communion is a two year process, and students must complete both first and second grade classes before receiving Holy Communion. Please contact the Religious Education Office with questions.

**Sacramental Preparation for Adults (RCIA):** Adults who wish to receive Baptism, First Communion, and/or Confirmation are invited to attend the Inquiry Class on Thursday evenings. Please contact the Parish Secretary or visit the website to register.

Dear Parishioners of Our Lady of Hope Parish:

I present to the parish community the annual financial statement for the fiscal year which ended on June 30, 2020. A combination of sound management and your very generous commitment over the years has placed us in a good position. Of note in the current report is that our loan balance is now less than \$2 million. We are on track to pay off the loan in November of 2025.

The parish completed a few major repairs and upgrades to the physical plant for both our church and school. Obsolete telephone equipment was replaced with that newly leased. The replacement of worn out parts of our heating and cooling systems totaled approximately \$19,500. This was in addition to our HVAC service and maintenance costs for which the Church pays \$12,780 and the School pays \$8,460, annually. Our utility bills (electric, gas, and water) average \$6,875 monthly for the Church and \$3,708 monthly for the school.

Naturally, as our beautiful buildings continue to age replacement of equipment can be expected. For example, the HVAC systems are reaching the end of their operational lives. I am told that replacing one compressor costs between \$15,000 and \$20,000 per unit including parts and labor. There are eight compressors in a large unit, and one compressor in each of the Church's four smaller units. The school has 11 compressors in its four rooftop units. For this reason, it is prudent for us to build up our capital reserves – even as we continue to pay off the construction loan.

This focus on building reserves for future major capital repairs comes at a challenging time. The threat of the coronavirus affect us all. For some, perhaps many, it has greatly affected household budgets. It is also affecting the budget here at Our Lady of Hope. Since March of this year, the offertory collection has been between eight and 20 percent below the previous year for every month but May, which saw an increase of just under six percent. As the offertory is the principal source of revenue for the parish, this downward trend gives me concern. Yet, I remain deeply grateful to so many generous parishioners who have continued to contribute regularly to our parish. I respectfully ask those who have not been contributing regularly to consider a renewed commitment to the offertory, perhaps giving electronically through Faith Direct.

Dear brothers and sisters, once again I express my thanks to God and to you for all that has been accomplished during the 20-year history of our parish. Please know of my prayers for all of you each day.




