
THE NATURE OF BEAUTY & SACRED MUSIC

Professor George Harne, PhD

Dr. George Harne is the president of the College of Saint Mary Magdalen in Warner, New Hampshire. Dr. Harne received his Ph.D. from Princeton University and received Masters Degrees from Princeton University, St. John's College, and the University of Washington. Dr. Harne has been honored with the Stanley J. Seeger and Naumberg Fellowships at Princeton University and the Harvey Fellowship awarded by the Mustard Seed Foundation. While at Princeton he was active in the Center for the Study of Religion and the Program in Hellenic Studies. Dr. Harne has been active as a scholar, publishing and presenting papers on Medieval music, Renaissance music, music in antiquity, and the contemporary philosophy of music. As a tutor at the College of Saint Mary Magdalen, he has taught courses in philosophy, Latin, and mathematics, while also teaching in the College's Honors Program.
