Say the Act of Contrition

<p>Prayers we say or something we do to make up for the hurt we have caused</p>	<p>You shall love your neighbor as yourself</p>
<p>Yes</p>	<p>Examination of Conscience</p>
<p>O my God, I am heartily sorry for having offended you, and I detest all of my sins because of your just punishments, but most of all because they offend you, my God, who are all good and deserving of all my love. I firmly resolve, with the help of your grace, to sin no more and to avoid the near occasions of sin. Amen.</p>	<p>Child: "In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit. Amen." "Bless me, Father, for I have sinned." "It has been _____ weeks since my last Confession. (Or, for the first time only: This is my first confession.)" "These are my sins." (name the sins). When finished, say: "For these sins and the sins of my whole life, I am very sorry." Priest: Gives words of advice and suggestion. Asks child to say a penance (prayers to be said in Church after Confession). Child: Says the Act of Contrition Priest: Gives Absolution (the words which remove sins). Child: "Thank you, Father."</p>
