The Sacrament which contains the Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity of our Lord Jesus Christ, really present under the appearance of bread and wine

Hail Mary, full of grace, the Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou amongst women, and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

The bread and wine change entirely into the **Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity** of Jesus.

Jesus paid for our sins by suffering and sacrificing Himself on the Cross on **Good Friday**

To redeem us from sin and to open the gates of Heaven
