Making the Most of Online Learning

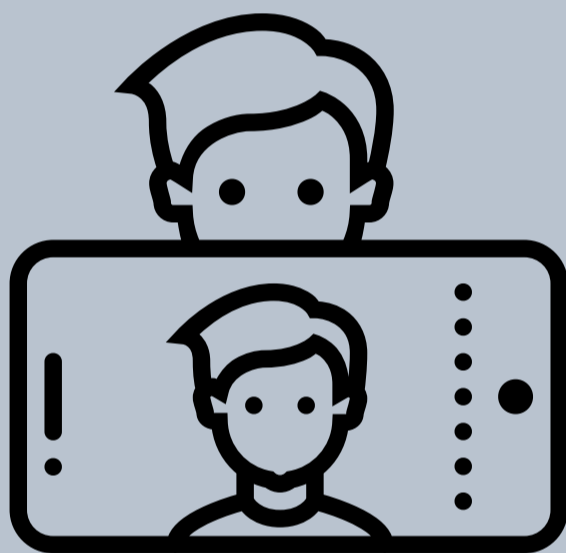


## BE PREPARED

Read and complete the assigned work before coming to class. Make sure your device is fully charged and working. Come to class on time. Turn on your video but mute yourself when asked by the teacher. Be ready to participate fully in class discussions and activities. Be ready to answer when called upon.

## YOU'RE ON CANDID CAMERA!

Seeing each other online during this time of social distancing is a great way to build community. You will be required to keep your video on for the entire class. But be aware that when your video is on, we can see you! Please be mindful of your attire, actions, and expressions.



## MINIMIZE DISTRACTIONS

Online learning can be challenging. Minimize distractions by choosing a quiet place and closing all other apps. Use headphones to mute outside noises, if needed. Avoid eating and drinking while the class is going on. Be respectful of others by avoiding using other devices or distracting others in class.

## GOT QUESTIONS?

Zoom technology prevents several people speaking at the same time. Mute yourself while the class is going on. You may use the CHAT function to ask questions or get the teacher's attention by using the RAISED HAND emoji on Zoom. Don't hesitate to ask for help or seek clarification when you need it.
